RE: DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT LEAD HAZARD CONTROL PROGRAM AWARD.

Dear Property Owner:

Have you heard the good news? Elkhart County has been awarded a \$3 million grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development under the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act to address lead hazards and educate on the detriments of lead poisoning. This program provides funding for three years to remediate as many pre- 1978 homes as (monetarily) possible of lead hazards. (Lead hazards primarily exist when windows and doors are painted with lead-based paint, however, other hazards such as high lead concentrations in soils and dust may also be addressed.) Our primary focus for remediation work is to provide lead-safe and affordable housing for low-income homeowners and renters (80% median income). However, all income categories are strongly encouraged to apply!

In an attempt to spread assistance further and benefit more, there are specific requirements that property owners must be aware of. 1.) Financial assistance will be available for up to 75% of the cost of completed remediation work. 2.) All participants must pay a minimum of 25% of the cost of completed remediation work.

- 3.) Occupants of assisted units will work with EMERGE Ministries on lead-safe cleaning practices.
- 4.) Remediation will be performed only by Indiana licensed Lead Abatement Contractors. 5.) All properties will be required to pass a lead-safe clearance test. 6.) Lead-safe certified properties will be posted on a public registry. 7.) Assisted properties will be required to be re-certified lead-safe for a fee.
