### Written Interpretation – Pet Grooming

Question: What zoning districts allow pet grooming?

**Relevant Code Citations:** 

#### **ARTICLE 1, SEC. 2.b**

**60.00 KENNEL.** Any lot or premises or portion of it on which a combined total of more than five (5) dogs, cats, and other household domestic animals over six (6) months of age are kept; or on which more than two (2) of such animals are kept for: (a) breeding, boarding or training for compensation, or for (b) the purpose of sale. (Amended 5/21/2012 PC12-04)

[Note there is no definition in the Zoning Ordinance for Pet Shop]

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**Interpretation:** A pet grooming business, with only indoor areas for grooming and the keeping of animals, should be treated like a "pet shop with indoor pens and/or runs" and therefore allowed by right in the B-1, B-2, B-3, M-1 and M-2 zoning districts. This is because the primary characteristic of a kennel, the keeping of animals overnight, either indoors or outdoors, is not taking place at a conventional, stand-alone pet grooming facility.

If a person proposes a pet grooming business with outdoor areas to keep the animals, or a combination pet grooming facility and kennel, then the provisions related to kennels would control.
